The Sixth Forum Physics and Society will take place in the University of Belgrade, Serbia (<http://www.forumphysicsandsociety.org/venue>), from Thursday 2nd until Friday 3rd October, 2014.

The conference aim is to share good practice and ideas that work in different countries to increase recruitment of physics students, to enhance the employability of physics students, to improve the image of physics amongst the public and to demonstrate the positive impact of physics on the economies of Europe in order to improve funding and support for research.

The purpose of the symposium is demonstrate effective ways to:

- improve physics teaching including how to improve careers advice and information to show the benefits of physics qualifications;
- demonstrate the skills of physics students to employers;
- engage the public with physics, and particularly the "hard to reach" publics who do not naturally wish to attend physics events;
- demonstrate to politicians the value of physics to the economies of Europe in order to increase support for funding.

The meeting will welcome Keynote Speakers (<http://www.forumphysicsandsociety.org/programme>) in the first part of the meeting and Invited Speakers in the second to share good practice during workshops.

Delegates are encouraged to bring examples of practice that has been effective in their own work to describe and demonstrate to others.

Registration is opened until September 1st, 2014.

The registration fee of 240,- (for regular) and 120,- (for students) includes:

- meals (lunches for both dates, coffee breaks and the conference dinner).
